He founded the band Dejavu Latin Fusion Rhythms in 2004, and the group released the record *Abriendo Caminos* in 2006. Before moving to Columbus, Enrique played with the Peruvian bands Los Mojarras and Pukakuntur. In 2010, he received El Premio Orgullo Peruano (Peruvian Pride Award) for his work as a successful artist outside of Peru.
